Simon- Boiko Duo

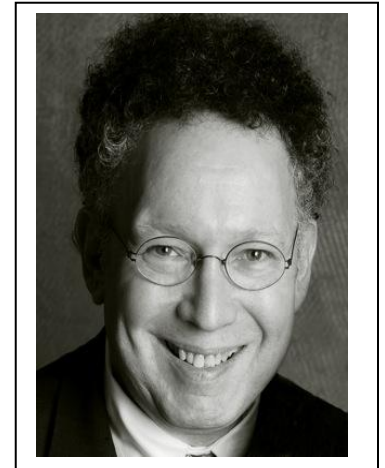
FRED SIMON



Fred Simon has been composing music for more than 40 years. This has included recordings, live performance, film, dance, and television, with instrumentation ranging from solo piano to symphonic orchestra. Since childhood, he was convinced that he is a singer/songwriter trapped in the body of someone who can't sing.

His recorded work includes seven albums of original music under his name: **SHORT STORY** and **TIME AND THE RIVER** (Quaver), **USUALLY/ALWAYS** (Windham Hill), **OPEN BOOK** (Columbia), **DREAMHOUSE** (The Naim Label), **REMEMBER THE RIVER** (The Naim Label), and, most recently, **SINCE FOREVER** (The Naim Label); three albums (as principle composer) with the Simon and Bard Group: **MUSAIC**, **TEAR IT UP**, and **THE ENORMOUS RADIO** (Flying Fish); as well as **TWILIGHT** (NorthSound Music Group), a collaboration with reed player Paul McCandless and guitarist Teja Bell; **THE MUSIC OF THE BEACH BOYS** (NorthSound Music Group), an album of solo piano arrangements of Brian Wilson songs; and numerous appearances on compilations released by Windham Hill, Columbia, Narada, Private Music, Imaginary Road, NorthSound Music Group, Jazziz Magazine, and, currently, The Naim Label.

Fred has recorded and/or performed with Ralph Towner (founding member of Oregon), Paul McCandless (founding member of Oregon), Larry Coryell, Lyle Mays, Iain Matthews (founding member of Fairport Convention), Jerry Goodman (Mahavishnu Orchestra violinist), Steve Rodby and Paul Wertico (both with Pat Metheny Group), Bonnie Herman (Singers Unlimited), Kurt Elling, Fared Haque, David Onderdonk, The Stan Kenton Orchestra and many others



ROBERT BOIKO



Robert Boiko began his musical journey at the age of four when he began playing the clarinet. Soon he was taking lessons from members of the Chicago Symphony, those lessons lasting for decades. In addition to classical training, he was influenced at an early age by Jewish Music, Blues and Jazz. He is now proficient on several other instruments in addition to his main instrument, Clarinet. Robert performs with Kavanah, a professional group that also leads Friday Night Live services at many of the pre-eminent synagogues in the Chicago metro area.

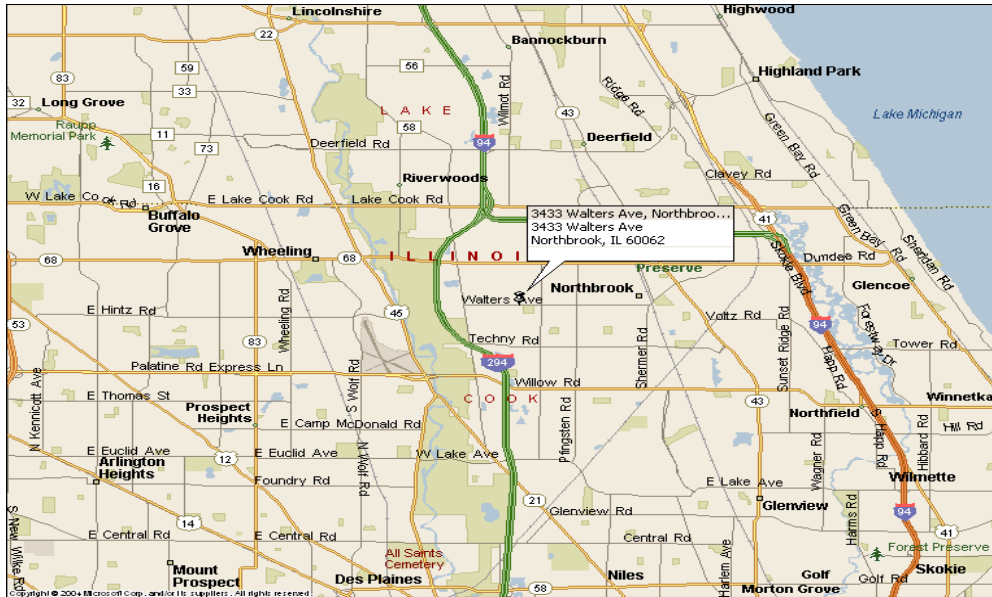
During Friday Night Live services, it is common to see him performing on the several other instruments to match the mood or the artistic needs of the music. He has also entertained for members of the U.S. Senate, the Illinois General Assembly, leading North American technology companies/organizations and numerous other business entities.

Besides the hours of practice each day, and his commitment to music, Robert is also an appointed commissioner (the law calls for certain technical standing to have this particular commissioner position), holds several patents in chemistry, electrochemistry and corrosion science.

Robert is a member of The Hadassah Associates and presented programs with Common Ground, a group that helps bring about a better understanding of religions with a goal of building mutual respect between people of different faiths. He currently participates musically as a Lay Leader for the United States Navy.
